### be willing to:

be happy to do something / having no reason not to do something

(喜んで~する)

#### recite:

to read a poem or something out loud in front of an audience

(朗読する、声に出して読む)

## reluctantly:

not wanting to do something

(しぶしぶ、いやいや)

### squinch:

to look something with the other eye shut to see it better

(目を細める、寄り目にする)

#### realize:

to notice a certain fact / to understand a situation (はっきり理解する、悟る)

#### weak-sighted:

having a poor vision / eyesight (目が悪い)
